Summary of curriculum vitae for Cliff Unwin

Long term experience, education and training

Cliff was a police officer for 33 years has served in all ranks to the rank of Senior Superintendent (higher grade) and left the service in 1997. He served in the Warrington Borough Police, Lancashire and Cheshire Constabularies. He gathered experience in a variety of departments of the service including Traffic, CID, Prosecutions, Criminal Records and HQ Operations Policy. Ten years of that service was spent in the operational CID in the ranks of D.C, D.S and D.I. He was a Divisional Commander at Warrington and Ellesmere Port, and his last role was at Chester Police Headquarters in charge of Uniform Operations Policy.

Cliff is educated to Honours Degree level in criminal psychology and is a Chartered Forensic Psychologist with British Psychological Society. He is also qualified in personnel management and training, a chartered member of Chartered Institute of Personnel and Development. He is a qualified management trainer and was a North West Regional trainer of Police Inspectors for 2 years.

He is a full member of the following Association of Security Consultants, Association of Auto Theft Investigators, Institute of Traffic Accident Investigators and a Member of Ex Police in Industry and Commerce, American Society for Industrial Security, Member of the British Standards Institute, and holds a managerial licence under the Security Industry Authority. Cliff was runner up two years ago as Warrington Business man of the year.

Hands on Experience

During the last 12 months of his police service being engaged in the planning, liaison, co-ordination, preparations and operational command of the Manchester Airport 2nd Runway Major Trespass in 1997. In this role it was necessary to deal with all levels of people from Senior Management people, contractors, and local authorities to the individual demands of the trespassers. It was necessary to manage aggravated trespass and the security and protection of land machinery and property and to engage in the eviction of trespassers of all ilks. Dealing with the media was part of the high profile operation. He also had hands on experience in the Major disorder of the national strikes of the printers unions and the miner's dispute. In his work as head of prosecutions he became very knowledgeable in Liquor licensing legislation and other licensing matters and the operational effectiveness in that industry and was a court advocate presenting police cases.

During the last 14 years Cliff has gained further experience in this field by his engagement as a Security Consultant on a variety of security and investigative issues and various forms of trespass, security issues and accident investigation. Cliff is also Consultant to several local authorities and national companies in dealing with land and property protection or security risk issues. He is the M.D of the company UNIQWIN UK Ltd who are actively engaged in this kind of work on a national basis.

Familiarity with the legislation

Cliff is well acquainted with all types of legislation concerning security, criminal investigation and the rights of wrongs of criminal and civil trespass. He ensures that he is kept up to date with legislation, in order to be of benefit to his clients and to provide protection from legal or illegal action. He has the ability and knowledge to apply the law in a practical way with the client's interests always being at the forefront. In the period since leaving the police service, Cliff has become much more aware and experienced in the application of quality issues, environmental issues, investors in people, and health and safety matters, having had to address these in his own company environment. He is also insured for personal indemnity. He also has knowledge and experience in dealing with disciplinary and Tribunal matters.

Other environmental and public order experience

Cliff gained much experience in dealing with major trespass situations and public disorder, engaged in the unlawful occupation of land / buildings, private or local authority issues both in the planning and in the operational activity to evict in the most effective and least troublesome way.

Cliff has also deal with more mundane matters such as fly tipping, major waste tipping, environmental nuisance such as motor cycling, illegal horse grazing, damage to and theft of environmental property.

He also engages ex senior police officers, experienced in trespass, environmental, criminal and civil law and other issues, in any part of the country.
